STATE	FUND NAME	DESCRIPTION
All States	AARP Foundation	The AARP Foundation is delivering essential food to seniors who are homebound and in need of assistance due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
All States	United Way COVID-19 Community Response and Recovery Fund	The United Way is protecting the most vulnerable by providing food and shelter to those in need.
Connecticut	4-CT Statewide COVID-19 Relief Fund	Launched in partnership with the Governor of Connecticut, this newly created charity is collaborating with community foundations across the state to disburse funding to first responders, food banks and more.
Massachusetts	Massachusetts COVID-19 Relief Fund	Established by First Lady Lauren Baker and the One8 Foundation, this fund is teaming up with philanthropists, business leaders, Eastern Bank and other foundations to provide statewide support for those impacted by the pandemic. The Fund will be coordinating with regional nonprofit and community leaders to systematically assess statewide needs.
New Hampshire	Community Crisis Action Fund	New Hampshire Community Foundation has undertaken a multi-pronged approach to deploying relief aid. The Foundation has been repurposing grants, coordinating with governmental organizations and community-based organizations and supporting other emergency funds to strategically disburse aid.
New Jersey	New Jersey Pandemic Relief Fund	Established by First Lady Tammy Murphy and other civic leaders, this fund will disburse grants across the state to vulnerable communities.
New York*	New York Community Trust Emergency Fund	This fund will help New Yorkers impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic by supporting a wide array of nonprofits providing critical services on the ground now and in the future. Your donation to this fund will help the city's most vulnerable, including people whose jobs have disappeared, and are threatened by losing access to food, shelter and health care.
Pennsylvania	PHL COVID-19 Fund	Philadelphia Mayor Jim Kenney joined the President and CEO of United Way of Greater Philadelphia and Southern New Jersey, as well as the President and CEO of the Philadelphia Foundation, to create the PHL COVID-19 Fund.
