Covered Service Lines

- Electric power
- Communication and data transmission (i.e., telephone, cable transmission, etc.)
- Drainage
- Fuel
- Water
- Waste disposal
- Compressed air
- Heat pump piping
- Sewer

Covered Perils to Service Lines

- Wear and tear
- Rust or corrosion
- Mechanical breakdown
- Collapse from aboveground weight
- Vermin, insect, rodents or other animals
- Artificially generated electric current
- Freezing or frost heave
- External force from excavation
- Tree or other root invasion
